Take notice that an inquiry will be conducted in the above matter by the Fitness to Practise Committee of the General Optical Council.

The Inquiry will be based upon the allegation submitted by the Council (see below) and will determine whether the fitness to undertake training of **Nabharn Bin-Amjid** is impaired by virtue of the provisions contained in section 13D(2) of the Opticians Act 1989.

ALLEGATION

The Council alleges that you, Mr Nabharn Bin-Amjid (SO-42093), a registered student optometrist, while on a placement at Specsavers, [redacted] and as part of your academic studies;

- 1) On 1 December 2024, submitted to UHI a false Witness Testimony Form for the Patient ID 139332, marked as Submission 13 in which you falsified the patient episode;*
- 2) On 11 December 2024, submitted to UHI a false Witness Testimony Form for the Patient ID 139332, marked as Submission 16 in which you falsified your supervisors signature;*
- 3) On 12 December 2024, submitted to UHI a false Witness Testimony Form for the Patient ID 139332, marked as Submission 18 in which you;*
 - (a) Falsified the patient episode;*
 - (b) Falsified your supervisors comments;*
 - (c) Falsified your supervisors signature;*
- 4) On 12 December 2024, submitted to UHI a false Witness Testimony Form for the Patient ID 102991, marked as Submission 19 in which you;*
 - (a) Falsified the patient ID;*
 - (b) Falsified the patient episode;*
 - (c) Falsified your supervisors comments;*
 - (d) Falsified your supervisors signature;*
- 5) On or around 12 December 2024, submitted to UHI a false Witness Testimony Form for the Patient ID 165005, marked as Submission 20 by claiming the patient episode as your own when you were not directly involved in the care of the patient;*
- 6) On or around 12 December 2024, submitted to UHI a patient encounter for the Patient ID 106874, marked as Submission 21 by claiming the patient episode as your own when you were not directly involved in the care of the patient;*
- 7) Between 11 November 2024 and 12 December 2024, submitted to UHI false Witness Testimony Forms for the Patient ID's 153372, 164974, 144839, and 164536, in which you falsified your supervisors signatures;*
- 8) Your actions at 1, 2, 3 and 4 and 7 above were dishonest in that you;*
 - (a) Knew they were not genuine patient episodes; and/or*
 - (b) knowingly falsified your supervisors comments; and/or*
 - (c) knowingly falsified the signatures on the Witness Testimony Forms; and/or*
 - (d) Submitted Witness Testimony Forms to UHI which you knew to be false;*
- 9) Your action at 5 and 6 above were dishonest in that you;*
 - (a) Knew you were not directly involved in the care of these patients;*
 - (b) Submitted a Witness Testimony Form and/or patient encounter which you knew to be false;*

And by virtue of the facts set out above, your fitness to carry out training is impaired by reason of Misconduct.
