Introduction

The Committee considered a Suspension Order of twelve months imposed on the registrant on the 12th July 2024. It noted that its role today was to consider whether the Registrant's fitness to practise remained impaired and if so, what sanction if any was appropriate. The Committee was mindful that its duty is the protection of the public and of the profession of Optometry.

Sitting in Private

The Committee received and accepted legal advice on the issue of sitting in private. The Legal Adviser directed the Committee to Rule 25. Having considered the nature of the allegation and the evidence before it, the Committee concluded that the entirety of the hearing should be held in private.

Findings regarding impairment

The Committee determined that the Registrant's fitness to practise is currently impaired.

Sanction

The Committee ordered that the Registrant's registration be suspended for a period of 9 months. The order will be reviewed prior to its expiration.
